29-117 Five-Year Local option levy for general government operations and maintenance.

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, November 4, 2008, General Election will be held by mail in Tillamook County, Oregon. The following shall be the ballot title for the measure submitted to the electors thereof:

29-117 Five-Year Local option levy for general government operations and maintenance.

QUESTION: Shall the District levy 40 cents (\$.40) per \$1,000 for operations and maintenance for five-years starting FY 2009-2010?

The measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.

SUMMARY: This measure authorizes North County Recreation District to levy up to 40 cents (\$.40) per \$1,000 of assessed valuation on real property in District for five years, beginning with FY 2009/2010. Proceeds of this levy will be used to fund District operations and maintenance. District has traditionally been subsidized by timber taxes; however, last year District received only 43% of revenues received in 2006. In addition, operational costs are rising and heating costs have increased substantially. The result of the reduction in timber tax receipts and increases in operating expenses is that services will be reduced again, as in 2008, if additional funding is not provided.

District estimates that the proposed local option levy, less uncollectible taxes, will raise the following:

FY 2009-2010 \$339,045  
FY 2010-2011 \$349,216  
FY 2011-2012 \$359,693  
FY 2012-2013 \$370,484  
FY 2013-2014 \$386,598

The estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the county assessor at the time of the estimate.
