12" Fir bears S23°E 38.2 ft.; scribed T3N R6W S36 BT, RE 2311.

Also poster on telephone pole on North Edge S.P.R.R. grade 1250 ft. North. 4" x 2" x 72" white Cedar post 1 ft. NE of pipe.
