

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 1, 2, 35 and 36,
Townships 3 and 4 North, Range 7 West, W.M.,
Tillamook and Clatsop Counties, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

- 72" Fir bears N28°E 11 lks.; now 64" stump, scribes BT visible.
- 9" Hemlock bears S72°E 58 lks; now 10" stub, 1 ft. high, log nearby with scribes T3N R7W S visible.
- 24" Hemlock bears S18W 20 lks.; now 36" uproot fallen on face, root hole in place.
- 18" Hemlock bears N33°W 11 lks.; now 24" stub 4 ft. high, face and scribes burnt off.

RESTORED

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T4N R7W S35 S36 S2 S1 T3N 1954 RE 2311," 33 inches in ground in mound of stone 2' x 2' x 10", and from which a:

- 64" Fir stump bears S89½°E 54.6 ft.; scribed T3N R7W S1 BT RE 2311.
- 50" Fir stump bears N53°E 33.9 ft.; scribed T4N R7W S36 BT.
- 47" Fir stump bears N18°W 109.6 ft.; scribed T4N R7W S35 BT.
- 74" Fir stump bears S67°W 81.5 ft.; scribed T3N R7W S2 BT.

Also poster on original 72" Fir BT.
4" x 4" x 72" white Cedar post 1.5 ft. SE of pipe.
