

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 14 and 23,
T3N, R6W., W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, (3/4x19 iron pin found out of place)

42" Fir bears S23 1/2°W 60 lks., now 44" stump, 1/4 S BT
Scribes visible.

10" Hemlock bears N60°E 22 1/2 lks.; now 12" uproot,
badly rotted.

RESTORED

Set the above pin in place, 13 inches in ground, and from
which a:

8" Fir bears N59°W 16.4 ft.; scribed 1/4 S14 BT RE 2311.

8" Fir bears S73°E 26.1 ft.; scribed 1/4 S23 BT.

Set 4"x4"x84" white Cedar post 1 ft. NW of corner pin.
