30" Hemlock bears N40°E 48 lks.; now 54" in diameter, scribes 4 S BT visible.

RESTORED

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY ½ S18 1955 RE2311," 30 inches in ground, in mound of stone, with original stone on N edge, and from which a:

56" Hemlock bears N55°E 63.3 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S18 BT RE 2311.

Set 4" x 4" x 60" white Cedar post 4" SE of pipe.
