20" Hemlock bears N272°W 33½ lks.; now 16" uproot, out of place, roots and root hole in place, scribes and face burnt off.

RESTORED

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY ½ S7 S8 1955 RE 2311," 33 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

12" Fir bears S79°E 7.0 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S8 BT RE 2311. 6" Fir bears N31°W 9.8 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S7 BT.

Set 4"x4"x72" white Cedar post 1.5' SW of pipe.
