RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8,
T. 2N, R.6W, W.M., Tillamook and Washington Counties,
Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post (now missing, found recently scribed post in place)
from which a:

- 24" Fir bears N32°E 41 lks.; now 26" snag, face unexposed.
- 24" Fir bears S80½°E 27 lks.; now 26" stump, scribe 8
remaining on upper face, lower face unexposed.
- 24" Fir bears S20°W 40 lks.; now 27" stump, lower face
remaining unexposed.
- 36" Larch bears N60°W 4.5 lks.; now 39" snag, scribe
R visible, rest unexposed.

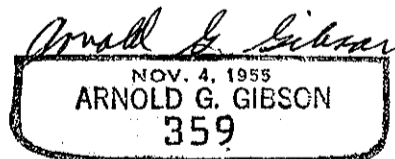
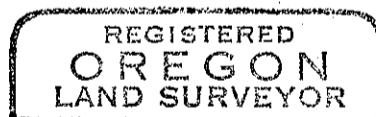
Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap
marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T2N R6W S5
S6 S7 S8 1956 RS 359," 26 inches in ground, in small
mound of stone, and from which:

- 5" Fir bears S11°W 20.9 ft.; scribed T2N R6W S7 BT RS 359
- 5" Fir bears N37°E 6.1 ft.; scribed T2N R6W S5 BT
- 5" Fir bears N85°W 14.5 ft.; scribed T2N R6W S6 BT
- 5" Fir bears S65°E 25.2 ft.; scribed T2N R6W S8 BT
