REESTABLISHED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

(See official plat)

One quarter corner common to Sections 20 and 29, T. 3S., R. 9W., W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Stone 10" x 6" x 6" in stone mound (not found)

REESTABLISHED

Var. 21-1/2°

Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S20 S29 1956 RS359," 34" in ground, in small mound of stone, and from which a:

6" Spruce bears N. 62° E. 4.9 ft.; scribed 1/4 S20 BT RS359.

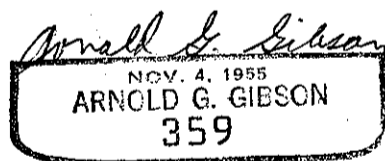
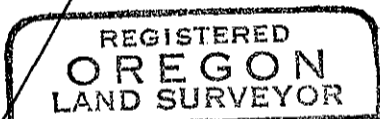
14" Fir bears S. 27° W. 65.4 ft.; scribed 1/4 S29 BT.

Set 4 x 4 x 60" white painted cedar post 1.5 ft. S.W. of pipe.
