

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Meander corner common to Sections 16 and 17 (on left bank of Nehalem River), T3N, R8W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

18" Maple (now missing) from which a:

50" Cedar bears S67°E 15 lks.; now 48" stump, scribes 8W S visible on rotted face.

12" Maple bears S20½°W 64 lks.; now 27", scribes and face unexposed.

RESTORED

Var. 21½°E

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY M C S17 S16 T3N R8W 1957 RS 359," 6 inches in ground, in mound of stone 30" high, and from which a:

17" fir bears S4°W 35.8 ft.; scribed T3N R8W S17 MC BT.

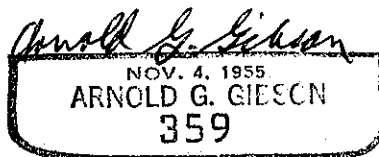
18" Fir bears S30°E 17.2 ft.; scribed T3N R8W S16 MC BT RS 359.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 18" Fir BT.

Set 4"x4"x60" white painted Cedar post on W edge of pipe.
