ESTABLISHED CORNERS FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

South One Sixteenth corner common to Sections 1 & 6,  
T. 2N, R. 9 & 10W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY S 1/16 S1 S6 1958 RS401," 34 inches in ground, in mound of stone on ~~W~~edge of 24" Alder uproot, and from which a:

31" Hemlock bears S32W 87.3 ft.; scribed S 1/16 S1 BT RS401.  
15" Hemlock bears N33W 68.5 ft.; scribed S 1/16 S1 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 15" Hemlock BT.  
Set 4 x 4 x 60" white painted Cedar post 2.5 ft. West of pipe.

Center South One Sixteenth corner for Section 6,  
T. 2N, R. 9W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

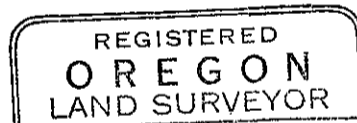

19" Spruce bears N73W 30.3 ft.; scribed CS 1/16 S6 BT.

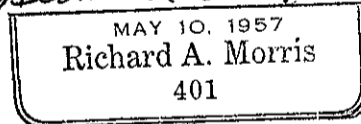
Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 23" Spruce BT.
