17" Fir bears S40W 87.1 ft.; scribed N 1/16 S25 BT.

Set 4" x 4" x 52" white painted Cedar post 1.0' W. of pipe.

South One Sixteenth corner common to Sections 25 & 30,

11" Hemlock bears S24E 9.8 ft.; scribed S 1/16 S30 BT RS401.

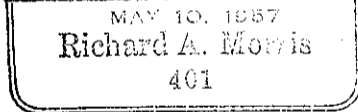
