ESTABLISHED CORNERS FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY
 (See official plat)
 South One Sixteenth corner for Section 22 (East side)
 T2S, R9W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

Var. $21\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$

Set $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY S 1/16 S22 1959 RS401", 33 inches in ground, and from which a:

24" Hemlock bears $N86\frac{1}{2}W$ 38.0 ft.; scribed S 1/16 S22 BT RS401.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 24" Hemlock BT.
 Set 4" x 4" x 56" white painted Cedar post 1.0' N.W. of pipe.

West One Sixteenth corner common to Sections 15 and 22, T2S, R9W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

18" Fir bears $S34E$ 87.6 ft.; scribed W 1/16 S22 BT RS401.
 25" Cedar bears $N4W$ 361.5 ft.; scribed W 1/16 S15 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 18" Fir BT.
 Set 4" x 4" x 56" white painted Cedar post 1.0' N.E. of pipe.
 Found $3/4$ " x 24" pipe 8.3' N. in East West fence line.
