ESTABLISHED CORNERS FOR STATE OF OREGON-DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY
(See official plat)
Center South One-sixteenth corner for Section 8, T1S, R8W,
W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE
BOARD OF FORESTRY CS 1/16 C---C S8 1962 RS401", 32 inches in ground, in
mound of rock, and from which a:

5" Spruce bears S31½E 20.9 ft.; scribed CS 1/16 S8 BT.
17" Alder bears S34½W 11.5 ft.; scribed CS 1/16 BT RS401 S8.
Nigger Jack Creek bears West 40.5 ft.; course South.

Set 4" x 4" x 52" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. NW of corner pipe.
Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 5" Spruce BT.

West One-sixteenth corner common to Sections 8 and 17, T1S,
R8W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

21" Spruce bears S25W 163.1 ft.; scribed W 1/16 S17 BT RS401.
48" Hemlock bears N14½W 181.1 ft.; scribed W 1/16 S8 BT.

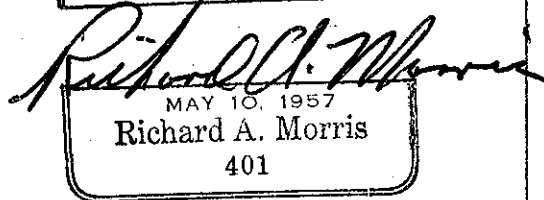
Corner is approx. 60' South of power line on edge of pasture land.

Set 4" x 4" x 52" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. NW of corner pipe.
