

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR THE OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

November 14, 1951

The corner to sections 9, 10, 15, 16, Township 2 South, Range 7 West, W. M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

- Post (now missing), from which a:
- 12" Hemlock bears N45 3/4E 38 lks; now a 12" stub badly burnt.
- 22" Hemlock bears N31 1/2W 20 lks; now only the roots remain.
- 20" Hemlock bears S26E 21 lks; now a 22" stub badly burnt.
- 30" Hemlock bears S75W 77 lks; now a 40" stub, badly burnt; scribe marks were visable when I was at this corner in 1947, since burnt out.

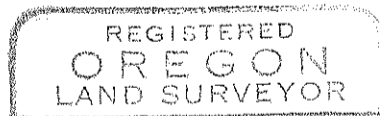
RESTORED CORNER & BEARING TREES

At the point for corner

Set a 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked, "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T2S R7W S9 S10 S16 S15 1951 142" 2 1/2 ft. in the ground, from which a:

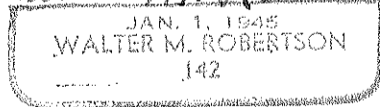
- 48" Fir stump bears N75W 96 lks; scribed T2S R7W S9 BT 142.
 - 66" Fir stump bears N32E 24 lks; scribed T2S R7W S10 BT 142.
 - 44" Fir stump bears S59E 169 lks; scribed T2S R7W S15 BT 142.
 - 64" Fir stump bears S03W 24 lks; scribed T2S R7W S16 BT 142.
- (Distances measured from center of bearing trees).

Nailed a metal location poster on the 64" Fir stump BT & marked it: Sec 16 T2S R7W Sec Cor 20 lks NOST.
