30" Hemlock bears S80W 21 lks; now a 32" stub, scribe marks BT exposed.

## RESTORED CORNER AND BEARING TREES

Set a 12" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap stamped "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S7 1949 199", 2 ft. in ground, from which a:

12" Fir stub bears S28E 24.3 ft; scribed 1/4 S7 199 BT.

Placed an Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 36" Hemlock stub and marked it: Sec 7 TlN R6W 1/4 Cor 23.1 ft. N62W.
