Original:

Post, From Which

Not Found,

20" Hemlock $340^{\circ}W$ 4Lks.

Short snag about 28" Diam. with a face but No scribe marks

14" Hemlock $N48^{\circ}W$ 38Lks.

24" Hemlock lying with Face almost down. Scribe Mark "5" plainly visible on piece of rotten wood which is about to fall out.

Restored Corner:

Set 3" x 3' spruce knot, scribed 516 on N Face and 521 on S Face, From Which,

24" Hemlock $376^{\circ}56'W$ 20⁴ scribed 1/45 E

Feb. 14, 1951.

Running East from this Corner Failed to find any evidence of original line or the section corner $\frac{14}{21}$ $\frac{15}{72}$. Topography does not check the original notes.
