30" Fir stub bears N45E 21.8"; scribed TlS R7W Sl5 BT 2311.

Placed an Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 49" Fir snag BT and marked it: Sec 16 TlS R7W Sec Cor 9.0 Ft S33E.
