

**CHAINS**  
**RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY**

Section corner common to sections 11, 12, 13 and 14, T2S R8W,  
 W.M. Tillamook County, Oregon.

**ORIGINAL**

- Post, now missing, from which a:
- 12" Hem bears N49W 43 lks; now missing, roots in place.
  - 5" Maple bears N61E 41 lks; now missing, roots and saplings in place.
  - 14" Hem bears S57°E 50 lks; 8 ft. section on ground with T2 scribes visible, root stubs in place.
  - 18" Fir bears S44W26 lks; now missing, roots in place.

**RESTORED**

Set 1½"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked  
 "Oregon State Board of Forestry T2S R8W S11 S12 S13 S14  
 1953 2311" 30 inches in ground, and from which a:

- 60" Fir Snag 50 ft. high bears N8W 64.3 ft.; scribed T2S R8W S11 BT.
- 50" Fir stump bears S49W 28.9 ft.; scribed T2S R8W S14 RE2311 BT.
- 48" Fir snag 50 ft. high bears N71E 150.3 ft.; scribed T2S R8W S12 BT.
- 40" Fir stump bears S3E 20.8 Ft.; scribed T2S R8W S13 BT.

Erected mound of rock around corner pipe.  
 Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 50" Fir stump BT.  
 Also poster on 40" Fir snag North 512 ft., south side of cat road.  
 Also poster on 2" Alder East 2335.0ft., West side South Fk. Trask road.
