

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to section 35, Base Line, T1N
R8W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

- 22" Hem bears N46W 57 lks.; 8 ft. rotted stub, BT scribe.
- 22" Hem bears S74E 15 lks.; roots in place, scribe on down chunk.

RESTORED

Set 1 1/2" x 40" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked
"Oregon State Board of Forestry 1/4 S35 BL S2 1953 2311",
30 inches in ground, in mound of rock, and from which a:

- 4" Fir bears N19E 49.1 ft.; scribed 1/4 S BT.
- 80" x 80 ft. Fir snag bears S31W 36.3 ft.; scribed 1/4 S RE 2311 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 2 1/2
inch Fir N58E 15 ft.

End of a cat road on ridge top bears S18W 288 ft.
