

CHAINS

REESTABLISHED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

(see official plat)

One quarter corner common to Sections 2 and 3, Township 1 North,
Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked
"OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S3 S2 1953 2311,"
33 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

45" Fir snag bears N44W 23.9 ft.; scribed 1/4 S3 BT RE 2311.
53" Fir stump bears S50E 11.9 ft.; scribed 1/4 S2 BT.

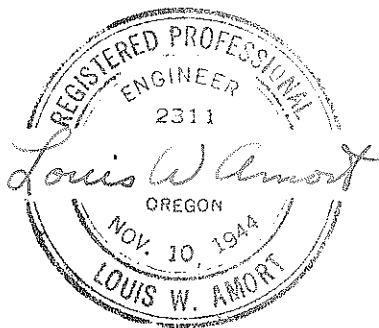
Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 45" Fir
