

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 32, 33, 4 and 5, Townships 1 & 2 North, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

- 30" Hemlock bears N40W 60 lks.; now down and out of place.
- 10" Hemlock bears N19E 56 lks.; destroyed by road.
- 4" Vine Maple bears S39E 28 lks.; missing.
- 15" Hemlock bears S57W 62 lks.; scribe marks on broken off slab.

RESTORED by Lyle Byers March 2, 1951.

1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T2N R7W S32 S33 S5 S4 TLN 1951 199," now 24 inches in ground, in good condition.

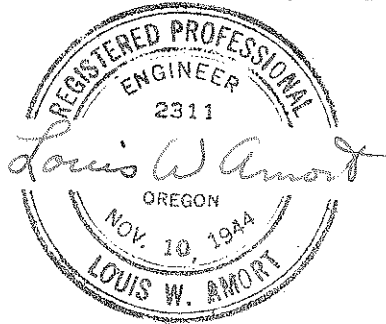
NEW BEARING TREES

- 55" Fir snag bears S25°30'E 86.6 ft.; scribed TLN R7W S4 BT RE 2311.
- 64" Fir stump bears N72°30'E 179.6 ft.; scribed T2N R7W S33 BT.
- 87" Fir stump bears N84W 83.8 ft.; scribed T2N R7W S32 BT.
- 48" Fir stump bears S45W 86.3 ft.; scribed TLN R7W S5 BT.

 Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 4" x 4" x 48" white cedar post 1.8 ft. North of pipe.
 Also poster on 4" x 4" x 48" white cedar post 62.5 ft. North on North edge road.
 Also poster on 4" x 4" x 6" post on ridge S13°30'E 750.0 ft.
 Also poster on 4" x 4" x 6" post on ridge S89°30'E 795.0 ft.
