

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 1 and 6, Township 1 South,  
Ranges 6 and 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

20" Hemlock bears N13E 24 lks.; now 24" stub 8 ft. high,  
scribes 1/4 S BT on ground.

3" Mt. Ash bears S89W 7 lks.; now 4" root stub 6 inches  
high.

RESTORED

Set 1 1/2" X 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked  
"OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S1 S6 1953 2311,"  
6 inches in ground, in large mound of stone 30" high, and  
from which a:

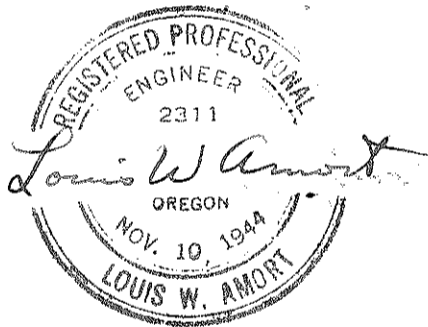
38" Fir snag bears N31E 25.6 ft.; scribed 1/4 S6 BT.

49" Fir snag bears S34W 3.0 ft.; scribed 1/4 S1 BT RE 2311.
