

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 8 and 9, Township 2 North,
Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

16" x 11" x 9" stone (in place) $\frac{1}{4}$ on West face from which a:

24" Hemlock bears S79W 20 lks.; now 42" stump, face burnt
out.

18" Hemlock bears S82E 44 lks.; now 27" stump, exposed
 $\frac{1}{4}$ scribe.

RESTORED

Set 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked
"OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S8 S9 1953 2311," 30
inches in ground on south side original stone, in mound of
stone, and from which a:

40" Fir stump bears S9W 18.0 ft.; scribed 1/4 S8 BT.

32" Fir stump bears N73E 26.8 ft.; scribed 1/4 S9 BT
RE 2311.

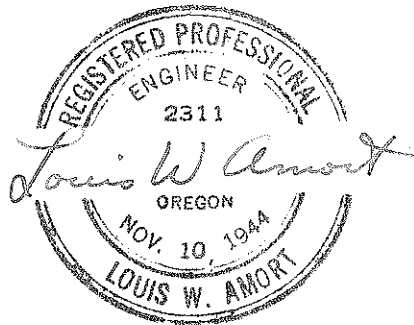
Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 32" Fir

pipe.

Also C-Z poster 200 feet south on south edge log road.
