

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 2 and 11, Township 2 North,
Range 6 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

16" x 12" x 12" stone, now missing, from which a:

- 6" Red fir bears N73E 29 lks.; now missing.
- 12" Alder bears S51E 72 lks.; now 22" stub 30 ft. high,
scribes 4 S visible.

RESTORED

Set 1½" x 40" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked
"OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S2 S11 1953 2311,"
28 inches in ground, in large mound of stone, and from
which a:

- 90" Fir stub 40 ft. high bears N82W 67.4 ft.; scribed
1/4 S2 BT RE 2311.
- 56" Fir stub 40 ft. high bears S75E 179.1 ft.; scribed
1/4 S11 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on original
12" Alder BT.
Also poster on 56" Fir stub.
White cedar post NE edge of pipe.
