

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14, Township 1 South, Range 8 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Stone, 18" x 12" x 7" (found out of place and replaced) from which a:

- 28" Fir bears N42W 49 lks.; now 48" stump cut off below face.
- 10" Hemlock bears N41E 75 lks.; now under a log.
- 12" Hemlock bears S32E 78 lks.; now 25" stub 10 ft. high, BT scribes visible.
- 14" Hemlock bears S37W 56 lks.; now 18" stump, face burned out.

RESTORED

Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T1S R8W S11 S12 S13 S14 1953 2311," 33 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

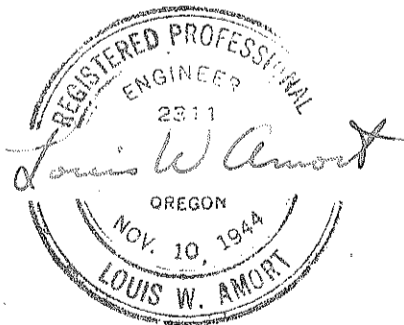
- 8" Alder bears S88E 10.4 ft.; scribed T1S R8W S13 BT.
- 62" Fir stump 20 ft. high bears N30°30'E 49.9 ft.; scribed T1S R8W S12 BT.
- 56" Fir stump bears S40W 32.2 ft.; scribed T1S R8W S14 BT RE 2311.
- 4" Alder bears N45°30'W 11.3 ft.; scribed X.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on original 12" Hemlock stub.

Also poster on 8" Alder BT.
White cedar post 1 feet north of pipe.
