S10BT.

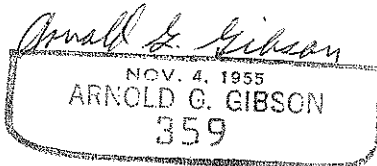
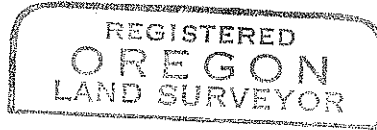
36" Fir snag bears $S14\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$. 170.6 ft.; scribed W 1/16
