ESTABLISHED CORNERS FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY
(See Official Plat)

North one-sixteenth corner common to Section 36 (East side)
T1N, R7W W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ESTABLISHED

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap
marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY N 1/16 S36 1956 RS 359,"
35 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

32" Fir snag bears N68°W 10.9 ft.; scribed N 1/16 S36 BT
RS 359

Set 4"x4"x60" white painted Cedar post 1 ft. NE of pipe.
Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 32"
Fir snag BT.

marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY N 1/16 S31 1956 RS 359,"
34 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

48" Fir snag bears N32°E 29.8 ft.; scribed N 1/16 S31
BT RS 359

Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post 1.5 ft. SW of pipe
Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 48"
Fir snag BT.
