ESTABLISHED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY
(See Official Plat)

West one sixteenth corner common to Sections 2 and 35,
Tps. 3 & 4 N, R. 8W, W.M., Tillamook & Clatsop Counties, Oregon.

ESTABLISHED

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap
marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY W 1/16 S2 S35
1956 RS 359," 33 inches in ground, in mound of stone,
and from which a:

17" Hemlock bears S78°E 59.7 ft.; scribed W 1/16 S2 BT RS 359.

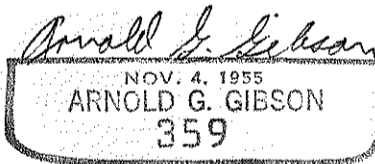
8" Spruce bears N58°E 47.2 ft.; scribed W 1/16 S35 BT.

Set 4"x4"x60" white painted Cedar post 1 ft. SE of pipe.
