ESTABLISHED CORNERS FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Northwest One Sixteenth corner for Section 11, T1N, R10W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ESTABLISHED

Var. 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ E

Set 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY NW 1/16 S11 1959 RS401", 16 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

- 13" Hemlock bears N 16 $\frac{1}{4}$ E 22.1 ft.; scribed NW 1/16 S11 BT.
- 66" Hemlock bears N 60 $\frac{3}{4}$ W 22.9 ft.; scribed NW 1/16 S11 BT RS401.

Set 4" x 4" x 52" white painted Cedar post 1.0' S.W. of pipe.
Corner sets in 12" creek, course N60E, 5 ft. below 10 ft. water falls.

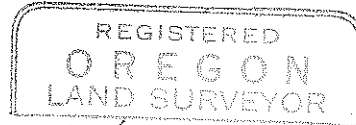
- 12" Fir bears S53 $\frac{1}{4}$ W 13.4 ft.; scribed CW 1/16 S11 BT RS401.
- 13" Hemlock bears N84 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 44.6 ft.; scribed CW 1/16 S11 BT.
- Wooden water tank bears S55E 38.0 ft.;
- 18" Creek bears East 26.0 ft.; course South.

Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post 1.0' N.W.
