Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY C 1/4 S11 1959 RS401", 48 inches in ground, covered with dirt, and from which a:

36" Hemlock bears N84 1/2 W 205.1 ft.; scribed C 1/4 S11 BT RS401.
10" Hemlock bears N57 1/2 W 173.5 ft.; scribed C 1/4 S11 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 10" Hemlock BT.
Also poster on 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post on W. edge of Miami Highway N89°43'58"W 195.9 ft.
Corner is in pastured bottom land.

West One Sixteenth corner common to Sections 2 and 11,
T1N, R10W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

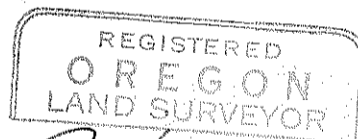

Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post 1.0' S.E. of pipe.
