ESTABLISHED CORNERS FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

North one sixteenth corner common to Sections 7 and
8, T3S, R8W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE
BOARD OF FORESTRY N 1/16 S7 S8 1960 RS401", 34 inches in ground, and
from which a:

12" Fir bears N62E 16.5 ft.; scribed N 1/16 S8 BT.

10" Hemlock bears S36W 5.2 ft.; scribed N 1/16 S7 BT RS401.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 10" Hemlock BT.

Set 4" x 4" x 52" white painted Cedar post 1.0 S.W. of pipe.

East one sixteenth corner common to Sections 6 and
7, T3S, R8W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE
BOARD OF FORESTRY E 1/16 S6 S7 1960 RS401", 34 inches in ground, in
small mound of stone, and from which a:

25" Hemlock bears S38½W 22.5 ft.; scribed E 1/16 S7 BT RS401.

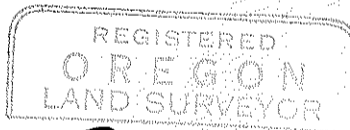
21" Hemlock bears N9½E 49.8 ft.; scribed E 1/16 S6 BT.

Set 4" x 4" x 52" white painted Cedar post 0.5' NE of pipe.
