WITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON-DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Witness Point (40" spruce line tree at S89° 04' W 9.80 chains from Sec. Cor. 13, 14, 23 and 24) common to Sections 14 and 23, T1N, R9W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

40" Spruce now 60" stump, notches on East and West sides, log laying alongside with 2 notches on East and West sides. (true bearing from Sec. Cor. now S87° 55' 21" W 637.2)

WITNESSED

Var. 21½E.

8" Spruce bears N71W 15.2 ft.; scribed WP S14 BT RS401.
11" Spruce bears N77E 28.3 ft.; scribed WP S14 BT.

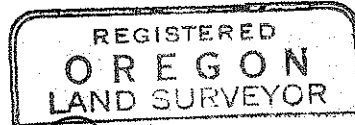
South fork of Kilchis River is south approximately 50 feet.
