

CHAINS

RESTORED FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Quarter corner common to sections 15 and 16, Township 1 South,
Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

8" Vine maple bears S70W 15 lks; now clump of small vine
maple only.

24" Hemlock bears S80E 23 lks; now 26" stub 20' high,
scribe marks BT exposed.

RESTORED CORNER AND BEARING TREES

Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked
"OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S16 S15 1952 2311," 2 1/2"
in ground, from which a:

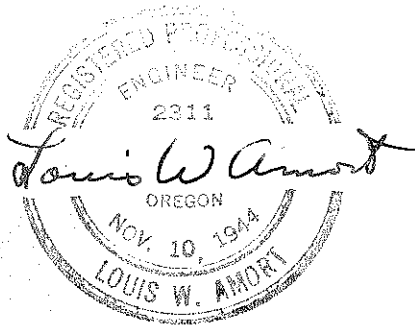
40" Fir snag bears S89E 27.2'; scribed 1/4 S15 BT RE 2311.

39" Fir stump bears S85°30'W 22.5'; scribed 1/4 S16 BT RE
2311.

Placed an Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster
on 39" Fir stump BT and marked it: Sec 16 T1S R7W 1/4 22.5 ft.
N85°30'E.
