

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to sections 32 and 33, on the South Township Line of T1N, R7W, WM., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

- 12" Hemlock bears N45W 14 lks; now missing.
- 36" Fir bears N56E 109 lks, now missing.
- 49" Fir bears S4E 61 lks, now 58" snag part of scribe mark exposed.
- 12" Hemlock bears S15W 85 lks, now missing.

RESTORED CORNER AND BEARING TREES

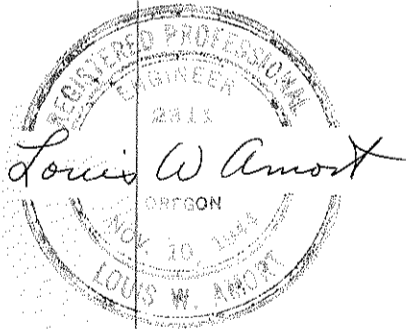
Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T1N R7W S32 S33 T1S R7W S4 1952 2311," 24" in ground, from which a:

- 66" Fir Stump bears N37°30'W 23.6'; scribed T1N R7W S32 BT RE 2311.
- 58" Fir Stump bears N62E 73.0'; scribed T1N R7W S33 BT.

Placed an Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 66" Fir Stump BT and marked it: Sec 32 T1N R7W Sec Cor 23.6 Ft. S37°30'E.

Dated August 15, 1952.
