

CHAINS

ESTABLISHED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

(see official plat)

South one-sixteenth corner common to Sections 2 and 3, Township 1 North, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY S 1/16 S3 S2 1953 2311," 32 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

55" Fir stump bears N74W 57.2 ft.; scribed S 1/16 S3 BT RE 2311.

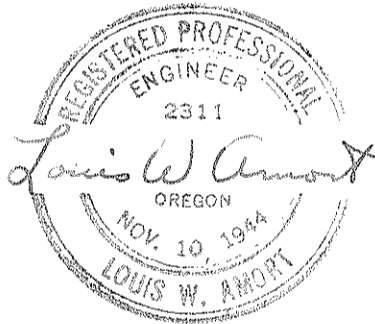
31" Fir stump bears S29°30'E 71.9 ft.; scribed S 1/16 S2 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 55" Fir stump BT.

Also poster on 4" x 4" x 6' white cedar post 1 feet North of pipe. Also poster on 4" x 4" x 6' white cedar post on ridge S16E 152.0 feet.
