

CHAINS

REESTABLISHED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

(see official plat)

One quarter corner common to Sections 4 and 5, Township 1 North,
Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon

No evidence of original corner found.

Set 1½" x 40" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked
"OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S5 S4 1952 2311," 30 inches
in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

50" Fir snag bears N27°30'E 55.9 ft.; scribed 1/4 S4 BT RE
2311.

5" Maple bears S44W 13.1 ft.; scribed X.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 50" Fir
snag BT.

Also poster on 4" x 4" x 48" white cedar post 1.4 ft. E. of pipe.

Also poster on 4" x 4" x 48" white cedar post on ridge 661.6 ft.
S13°30'E.

Also poster on 4" x 4" x 48" white cedar post on ridge 1125.0 ft.
S88°49'E.
