

CHAINS

ESTABLISHED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

(see official plat)

West one-sixteenth corner common to Sections 34 and 3, Townships 1 and 2 North, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

Set 1½" x 40" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY W 1/16 S34 S3 1953 2311," 30 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

45" Cedar snag bears S15°30'W 106.8 ft.; scribed W 1/16 S3 BT.

56" Fir stump bears N76E 158.0 ft.; scribed W 1/16 S34 BT RE 2311.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 4" x 4" x 48" white cedar post 250.0 ft. N89°E on West shoulder road.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 45" Cedar snag BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 4" x 4" x 48" white cedar post 18" in ground 0.7 ft. North of pipe.
