

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 5 and 6,
Township 3 South, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County,
Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

- 12" Hemlock bears N20E 40 lks.;
now 14" stub 12 ft. high, bears N13E,
BT scribes visible.
- 10" Hemlock bears N63W 12 lks.;
now 11" stub 7 ft. high, bears N53W,
top of old face showing, no scribes
remaining.

RESTORED

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap
marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY ¼ S5 S6
1953 2311,"
30 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from
which a:

- 16" Fir snag bears S85W 29.5 ft.;
scribed ¼ S 6 BT.
- 42" Fir snag bears N71E 58.2 ft.;
scribed ¼ S 5 BT RE 2311.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster
on 42" Fir snag BT.
4" x 4" x 48" white Cedar post 1 ft. north of
pipe.
