

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 10 and 15,
T. 3 N., R. 6W., W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Stake (now missing) from which a:

50" Fir bears N11 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E 14 lks.; now 53" stump, Scribe T remaining.

40" Cedar bears S50°E 20 lks.; now 29" uproot, roots and root hole in place, faces burnt out.

RESTORED

Set 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY $\frac{1}{4}$ S10 S15 1955 RE 2311," 32 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

6" Fir bears S30°E 10.4 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S 15 BT.

6" Fir bears N12°W 3.0 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S10 BT RE 2311.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 5" Noble Fir S21 E 3.1 ft.

Set 4" x 4" x 72" white painted Cedar post 1.5 ft. NW of pipe.

Dated November 17, 1955.
