

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 7, 8, 17 and 18,
Township 1 South, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post (now missing) from which a:

- 16" Hemlock bears N77°W 83 lks.; now 24" snag, scribes 7 BT. visible, rest unexposed.
- 12" Hemlock bears S53½°W 45 lks.; now 17"x7" high stub, scribes T1S R7W BT remaining.
- 16" Hemlock bears S47½°E 28 lks.; now 12"x4" high stub.
- 14" Hemlock bears N33½°E 20 lks.; now 23"x10" high stub, scribes BT remaining.

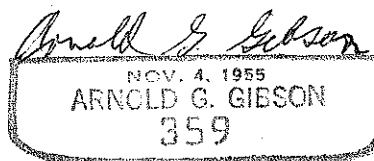
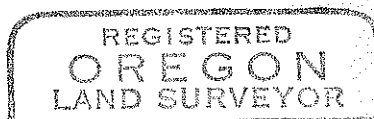
Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T1S R7W S7 S8 S17 S18 1956 RS 359," 34 inches in ground, and from which a:

- 48" Fir stump bears N30½°W 34.5 ft.; scribed T1S R7W S7 BT RS 359.
- 67" Fir stump bears N17°E 17.0 ft.; scribed T1S R7W S8 BT.
- 45" Fir stump bears S15½°W 21.8 ft.; scribed T1S R7W S18 BT.
- 8" Alder bears S35°E 50.5 ft.; scribed T1S R7W S17 BT (in bark)

Set 4"x4"x60" white painted Cedar post 1 ft. NE of pipe. Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 48" stump BT.
