Set $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked
"OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY N 1/16 S10 S11 1956
RS359," 35 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from
which a:

32" Maple bears $S68^{\circ}W$. 54.6 ft.; scribed N 1/16 S10BT
(This tree on west side of Bent Smith Cr.)

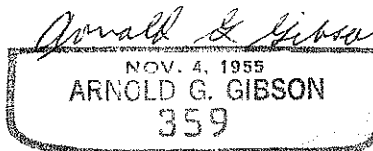
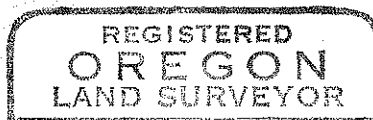
24" Maple bears $S19\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$. 34.1 ft.; scribed N 1/16 S11BT
RS359.

Set 4 x 6 x 72" white painted cedar post 1 ft. SE of pipe.
Corner point falls 10 ft. east of east bank of Creek.
