ESTABLISHED CORNERS FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Center One Quarter corner common to Section 8, T. 3S., R. 7W., W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ESTABLISHED

Var. 21-1/2° E.

Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY C 1/4 S8 1957 RS359," 34 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

22" Fir bears N.7° E. 36.4 ft.; scribed C 1/4 S8 BT.

23" Fir bears S.7 1/2° E. 19.8 ft.; scribed C 1/4 S8 BT RS359.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 23" Fir BT. Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted cedar post 1.0' S.W. of pipe

Center West One Sixteenth corner common to Section 8, T. 3S., R. 7W., W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

Var. 21-1/2° E.

Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY W 1/16 C—C 1957 RS359," 33 inches in ground, and from which a:

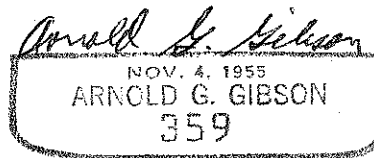
12" Cedar bears S.3° E. 32.8 ft.; scribed CW 1/16 S8 BT.

26" Fir bears N.85° E. 96.7 ft.; scribed CW 1/16 S8 BT RS359.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 12" Cedar BT. Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post 1.0' S.E. of pipe.
