

BOUNDARY SURVEYS

SECTIONS 16 & 21, T2N, R7W, W.M.

June 11, 1957, with Rob't. L. McCullough, at the site of the second temporary post, for the corner to sections 17, 16, 20 & 21, T2N, R7W, W.M., I set a 1 1/2" galvanized iron pipe 30" long 20" deep in loose soil and broken rock on steep hillside from which:

A stump 40" diameter bears N 50° E 14.4 feet marked S16 BT.

A stump 42" diameter bears N 44 1/2° W 102.4 feet marked S17 T2N R7W 1957 BT.

A stump 40" diameter bears S 69° W 126.7 feet marked S20 S22 BT.

A stump 48" diameter bears S 31 1/2° E 80.4 feet marked S21 BT.

Subsequent observation from the 1/4 corner between sections 16 & 17 show this point to bear S 0° 21' E from said 1/4 corner.

The angle between the east and west halves of the line between sections 16 and 21 was determined by transit. True bearings could not be obtained because of continued overcast.
