BOARD OF FORESTRY E 1/16 S1 S12 1961 RS401", 33 inches in ground, and
from which a:

20" Fir bears S42E 15.3 ft.; scribed E 1/16 S12 BT RS401.

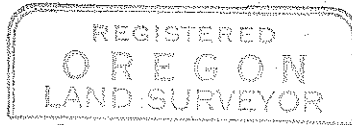
19" Spruce bears N74E 78.9 ft.; scribed E 1/16 S1 BT.
