RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON-DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Township corner common to Sections 31, 36, 1 and 6,
T3 and 4S, R9 and 10W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post (now missing) from which a:

- 5" Fir bears N17°E 238 lks.; now 20" badly rotted 2' high stub, backcast of scribe found inside, rest rotted away.
- 5" Fir bears N74°W 93 lks.; now missing, open field.
- 15" Fir bears S82°W 159 lks.; now missing, open field.
- 4" Maple bears S58°E 78 lks.; now missing, open field.

RESTORATION by County Surveyor

Post (now missing) from which a:

- 8" Fir (original) bears N17°E 238 lks.; See Above.
- 16" Hem. bears S39½°W 258 lks.; now 32" Hem. stub, backcast of scribe S found inside on partly exposed face (now bears S43°W 203.5 ft.).

RESTORED

Var. 21½°E

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T3S T4S R9W R10W S31 S36 S1 S6 1965 RSA01", 32 inches in ground, in mound of rock, and from which a:

- 14" Fir bears N89 ¼°W 214.5 ft.; scribed T3S R10W S36 BT.
- 19" Fir bears N50°E 140.2 ft.; scribed T3S R9W S31 BT RSA01.
- 18" Fir bears S48½°E 252.4 ft.; scribed T4S R9W S6 BT.

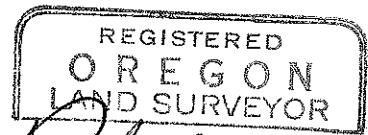
Corner is 4.5' South of an East and West fence line.

Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post 1.2 ft. NE of corner pipe. Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 14" Fir BT.
