

CHAINS

REWITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON—DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

East one-sixteenth corner (common to) Sections 4 and 9,  
T1S, R9W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

2" galvanized iron pipe with 3" BLM bronze cap (in place)  
from which a:

22" Fir bears N7°E 112 lks.; now 24" burnt stump, scribes  
E 1/16 S4 BT visible on partially grown over burnt  
face (now bears N11°E).

13" Hem. bears S64½°W 18 lks.; now 14" burnt stump, scribes  
burnt away, outer edge of face remaining.

Var. 21½°E

37" Fir stump bears S58°E 79.9 ft.; scribed E1/16 S9 BT RS 707.

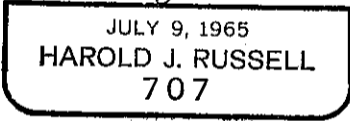
