

Dependent Resurvey of Base Line, Portion of E. Bdy. of T. 1 N., R. 9 W.

Chains

(Restoring the 1856 survey by Samuel D. Snowden
and the 1884 resurvey by Henry Maldrum)

From the corner of Townships 1 North, Ranges 8 and 9 West, previously described.

S. 87° 17' W., along the S. boundary of Section 36, marking and blazing the true line.

Ascend 78 ft. over SE. slope, through scattering live timber and dense undergrowth.

- 5.14 Spur, slopes S. 20° W.; descend 280 ft. over steep W. slope.
- 13.32 Branch, 5 lks. wide, course S.; ascend 123 ft. over steep E. slope.
- 15.595 Point for the E. 1/16 sec. cor. of Section 1 only, at proportionate distance in departure on the N. bdy. of T. 1 S., R. 9 W.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A hemlock, 29 ins. diam., bears S. 59° E., 52 lks. dist.,
mkd. E 1/16 S1 BT.

A fir, 33 ins. diam., bears South, 130½ lks. dist.,
mkd. E 1/16 S1 BT.

The corner falls in a slide area.

Ascend 170 ft. over steep E. slope.

- 19.03 Spur, slopes SE.; descend 10 ft. along S. slope.
- 22.44 Ravine, drains S. 20° E.; ascend 140 ft. over SE. slope, changing to S. slope.
- 26.12 Top of ascent, slopes S.; descend 150 ft. along S. slope.
- 34.04 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of Section 1 only, on the N. bdy. of T. 1 S., R. 9 W., hereinafter described.
- Descend 20 ft. along S. slope.
- 36.00 Top of rock bluff, 120 ft. high, edge bears N. and S. curving to SE.
- 37.265 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of Section 36 only, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. No permanent monument established.
- Continue across SW. slope in creek bottom.
- 38.00 Branch, 4 lks. wide, course S. 20° E.; ascend 597 ft. over steep E. slope, changing to SE. slope.
- 51.26 Spur, slopes SE.; descend 12 ft. over SW. slope.
- 55.34 Top of rock bluff, 100 ft. high, edge bears N. and SE.
- 57.00 Branch, 4 lks. wide, course SE. from N. 20° W.; ascend 484 ft. over steep rocky NE. slope.
- 66.70 Top of ascent, slopes N.; ascend 30 ft. over NW. slope.

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
