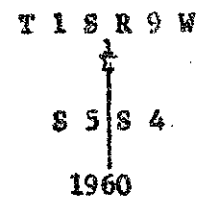


Dependent Resurvey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines of T. 1 S., R. 9 W.

Chains
39.77

Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 5, at proportionate distances; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



from which

A fir, 27 ins. diam., bears S. 60° E., 39 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S4 BT.

A fir, 27 ins. diam., bears N. $41\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ W., 39 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S5 BT.

Ascend 430 ft. over steep, rocky S. slope.

Main ridge, bears N. 80° W. and S. 80° E.; desc. 470 ft. over NE. slope.

Spur, slopes NE.; desc. 670 ft. over steep, NW. slope.

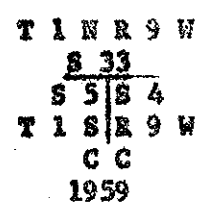
Branch, 3 lks. wide, course N. 40° E.; desc. 25 ft. along E. slope.

Intersect the Base Line.

Point for the closing corner of secs. 4 and 5, at proportionate distance in departure; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



from which

A hemlock, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 58° E., $33\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., mkd. T1S R9W S4 CC BT.

A hemlock, 27 ins. diam., bears S. $71\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ W., $47\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., mkd. T1S R9W S5 CC BT.

From this point the cor. of secs. 32 and 33 only, on the S. bdy. of T. 1 N., R. 9 W., bears N. $89^\circ 11'$ W., 0.89 chs. dist., previously described.

Land, mountainous.
Soil, rocky clay with numerous rock outcroppings.
Timber, hemlock, spruce, fir, and alder; undergrowth, salmonberry, devil's-club, huckleberry, vine maple, thimbleberry, sword fern, and reproduction.

To complete the survey of sec. 4, I return to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 33 only, on the S. bdy. of sec. 33, T. 1 N., R. 9 W., and run S. $89^\circ 11'$ E., along the N. bdy. of sec. 4.
