

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 7, 8, 17 and 18,
Township 1 South, Range 9 West, W. M., Tillamook
County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post (missing) from which a:

- 32" Spruce bears N 53 W 8 lks.; now rotten stub 1' high, face and scribes rotted away.
- 40" Spruce bears S 48 W 56 lks.; now 44" stub, scribes BT on partially exposed face.
- 64" Spruce bears S 21 E 55 lks.; now 42" stump, scribes 17 on rotten face (now bears S 31 $\frac{1}{4}$ E).
- 16" Spruce bears N 24 E 50 lks.; missing.

RESTORATION by Unknown Party (No record found).

Found the following bearing trees:

- 21" Cedar bears N 13 3/4 W 14.4 ft.; CS S7 scribes visible.
- 21" Cedar bears N 11 $\frac{1}{4}$ E 22.8 ft.; CS S8 BT scribes visible.
- 16" Fir bears S 20 $\frac{1}{4}$ E 22.4 ft.; face and scribes grown over.
- 16" Fir stump bears S 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 22.4 ft.; scribes CS S18 BT visible.

RESTORED

Var 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ E

Set 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY TLS R9W S7 S8 S18 S17 1967 RS 707", 33 inches in ground and from which a:

- 16" Fir bears S 49 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 22.8 ft. from face; scribed TLS R9W S17 BT RS 707.
- 19" Hemlock bears N 25 3/4 E 36.3 ft. from face; scribed TLS R9W S8 BT.

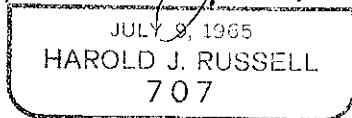
Set 4" x 4" x 50" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. SE of corner pipe. Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 16" Fir BT.
