

AFFIDAVIT

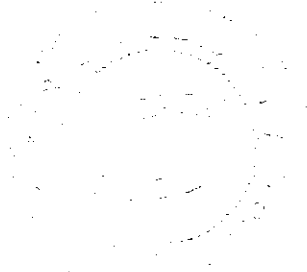
I, Glenn B. Cole, of Beaver, Oregon, being first duly sworn, do depose and say as follows:

I am over fifty years old and have lived on this place for more than thirty years. In September, 1935 I was cutting some down fir logs for firewood and on splitting open a block I had cut, found scribing on a 4" diameter piece which read "1/16 C.S.". This is the same scribing and piece of wood which is now nailed to a fence post at the site. The stump of the tree from which the block of wood was cut still remains as a 30 inch or so stump which bears N30°W., 14 links from a 2 inch pipe which John L. Carlich, the County Surveyor, had set from notes for random corner as stated in survey made on September 19, 1899 as recorded in Book "S3", Surveyor's Record, at Page 280.
